**"The Mission of Solebury School is to create an environment of educational excellence that prepares students for college and beyond"**

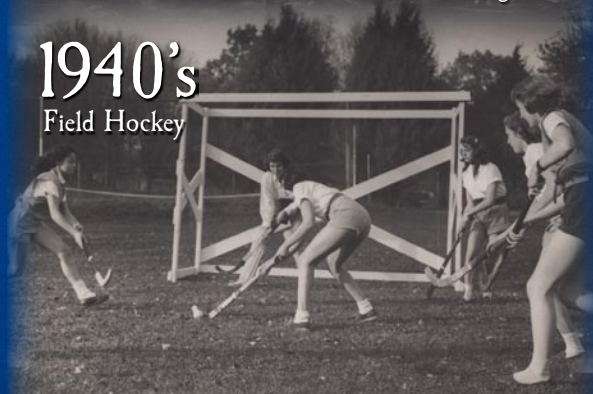
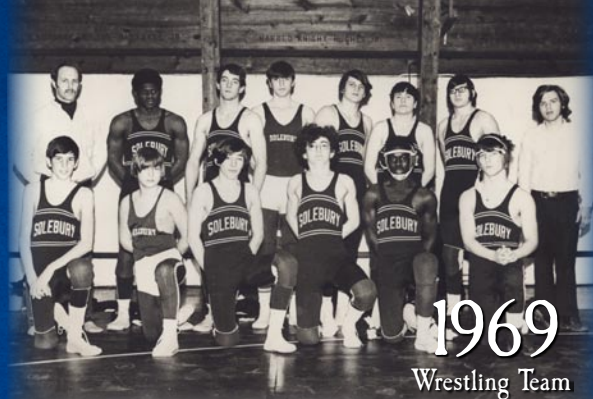
The Board's Long Range Strategic Plan has guided the school over the last nine years as Solebury has made significant improvements to its facilities.

- ♦ Walter Lamb Hall was built 1998
- ♦ New Faculty Housing was completed in 2002
- ♦ The Abbe Science Center was built in 2002
- ♦ Penny International Center was created in 2003
- ♦ All classrooms were renovated and refurbished in 2004
- ♦ The Learning Skills Center was renovated in 2005

At the same time Solebury School has:

- ♦ Increased the number of faculty to keep the teacher/student ratio low
- ♦ Added more AP and honors classes
- ♦ Provided more opportunities for independent study
- ♦ Improved the schedule to allow more students to participate in the chorus and instrument ensemble groups
- ♦ Increased financial aid
- ♦ Maintained a diverse student body
- ♦ Continued to develop and enhance the challenging curriculum

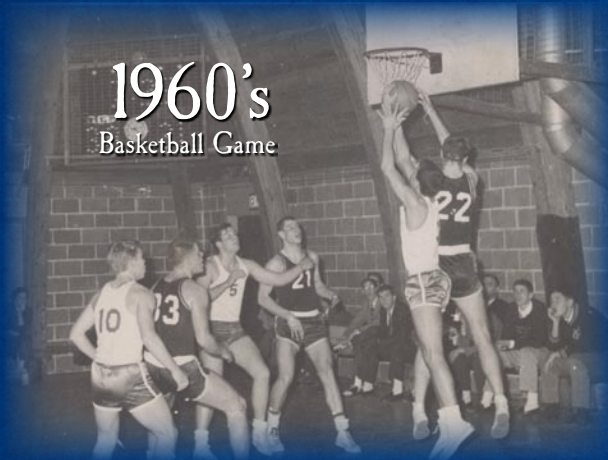

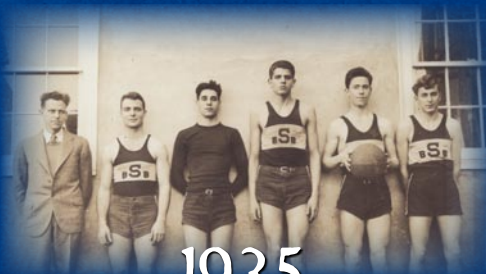
